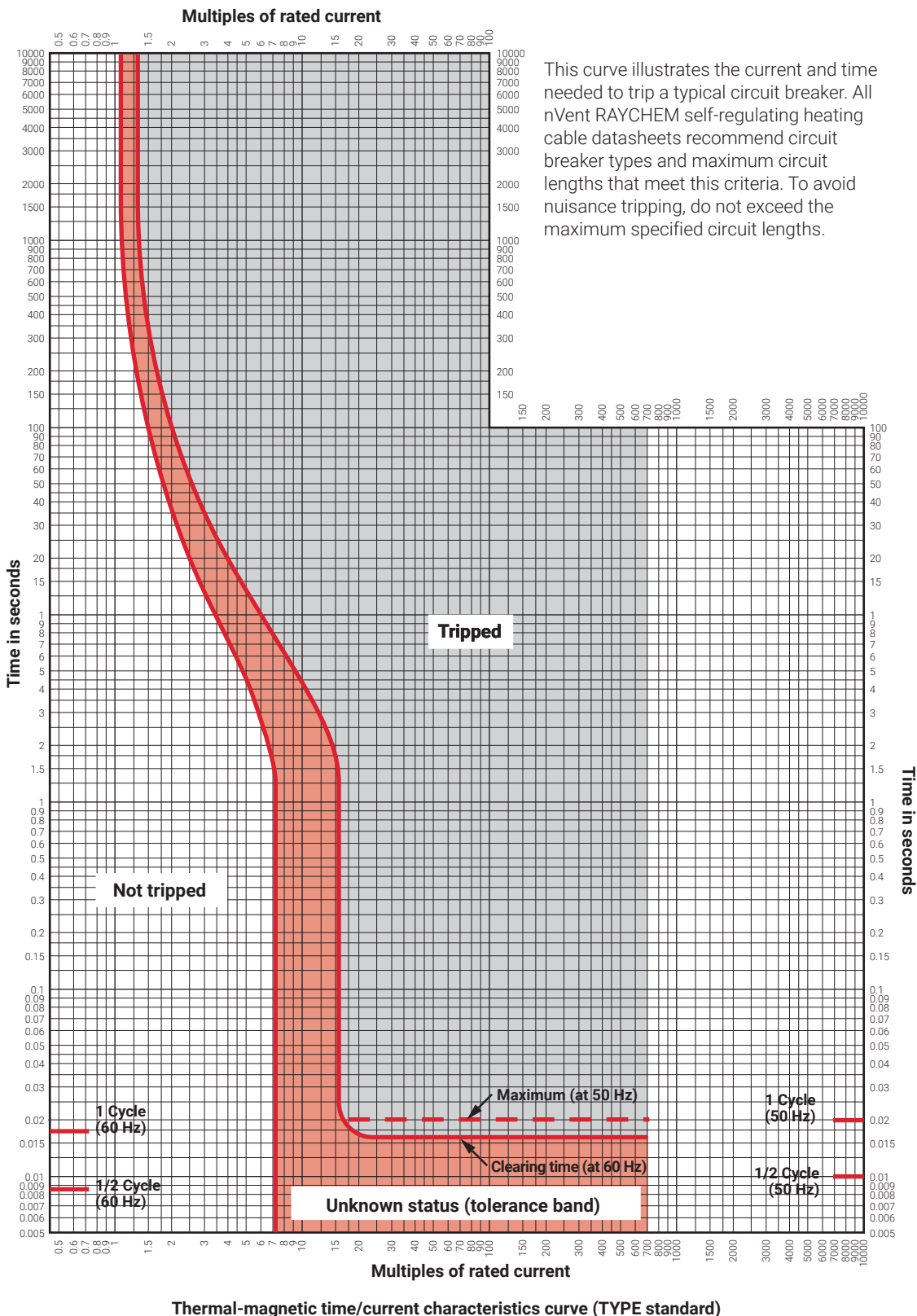


TYPICAL CIRCUIT BREAKER TRIP CURVE



This curve illustrates the current and time needed to trip a typical circuit breaker. All nVent RAYCHEM self-regulating heating cable datasheets recommend circuit breaker types and maximum circuit lengths that meet this criteria. To avoid nuisance tripping, do not exceed the maximum specified circuit lengths.
